RE: PUBLIC HOLIDAYS FOR 2022

Please find the list of prescribed Public Holidays for the year 2022.

The observance of Public Holidays is governed by the Public Holidays Act, **(Cap 190)** and **Public Holidays (Amendment) Act, 2014** which provide that the under-mentioned days shall be Public Holidays.

The list of Public holidays in the year 2022 shall be as follows:

**First and Second of January
Good Friday * (15 April)
Easter Saturday* (16 April)
Easter Monday *(18 April)
Labour Day (01 May)
The Fete Dieu (Corpus Christi)* (16 June)
Constitution Day (18 June)
Independence (National) Day (29 June)
Assumption Day (15 August)
All Saints Day (01 November)
The Feast of the Immaculate Conception (08 December)
Christmas Day (25 December)**

Public Holidays marked with **an asterisk (*)** are religious holidays and their dates vary each year.

Where any Public Holiday except Sunday falls on a Sunday, the next following day, not being itself a Public Holiday, shall be a Public Holiday. In the year **2022 Monday 3 January** will also be a Public Holiday since **2 January** which is a Public Holiday falls on a Sunday.
